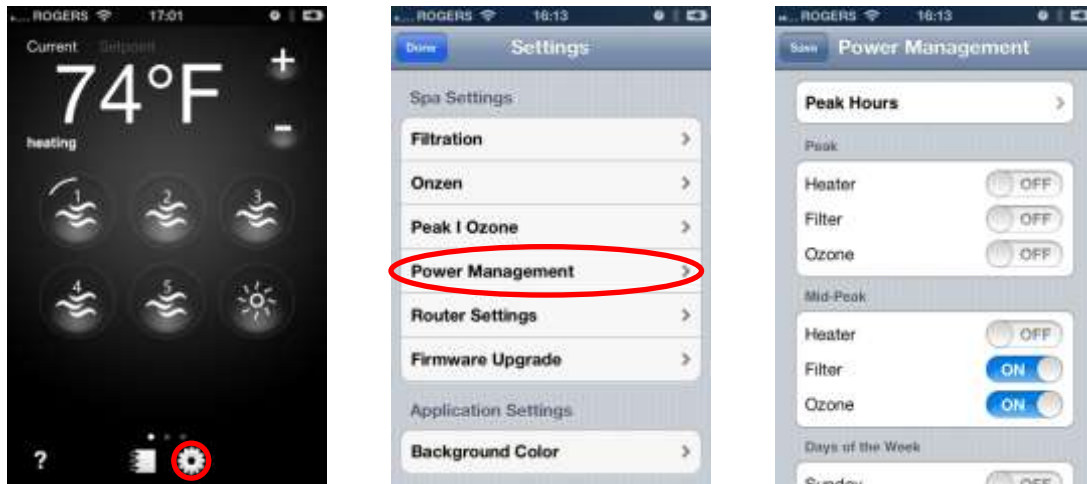


Power Management

The power management system is used to keep the power consumption of the spa down with variable power billing locations. Using the power management options allows the user to control what functions are available at different times of the day, and what days of the week that the spa functions in economy mode.

Setting Up Power Management



The power management settings are updated using the app on an iOS device. To get to the power management screen, click on the settings menu at the bottom of the main app screen.



In the settings menu, press on the “Power Management” item. This will bring you to the main power management screen. On the power management screen there is the button to set the peak hours, the switches to control what features are available during the mid-/peak hours, and what days of the week the power management runs on.

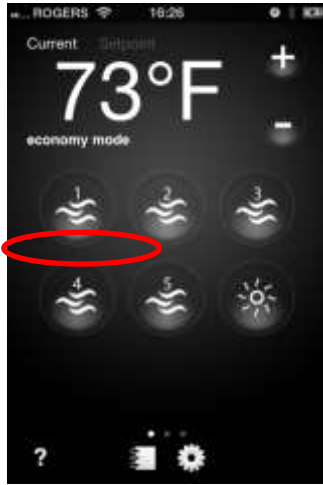
Turning a feature off means that feature will not run during the mid-/peak hours. If the switch is in the on position, then the feature will function normally during the mid-/peak hours.

Pressing on the “Peak Hours” button brings up the “Peak Management” screen. Here the start and stop times of the peak hour settings can be dragged around to set when each of the regions occurs.

Once all of the settings are finished, press the



Save buttons in the top left of the menu to save your settings.



When the spa is in economy mode, the status is displayed on the main screen under the temperature.

(Note: when power management is engaged the topside will flash ECON once per minute)
